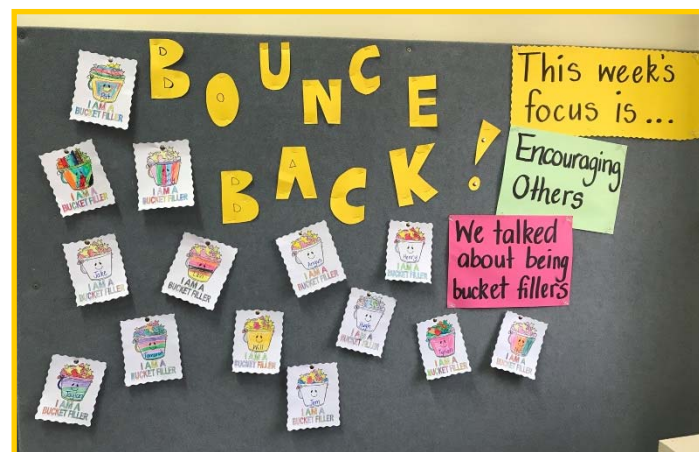
Such heart-warming words from classmates and friends, learning skills for life.

Class 5-6

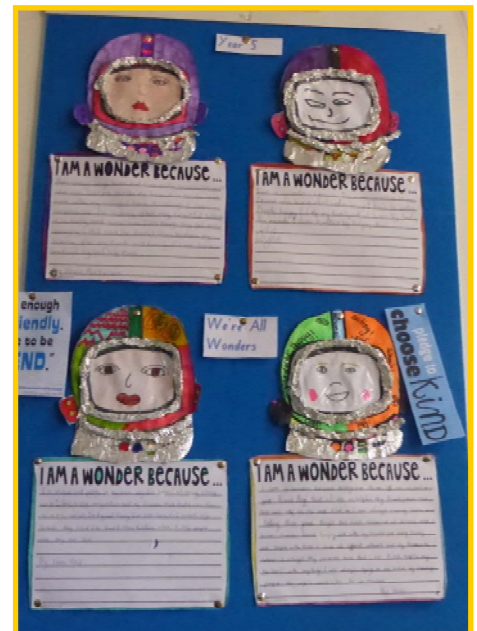
This week we have been learning about gold. We have made gold pans in class. We have been writing an information report and some of us chose to write about gold. It has been interesting for us.

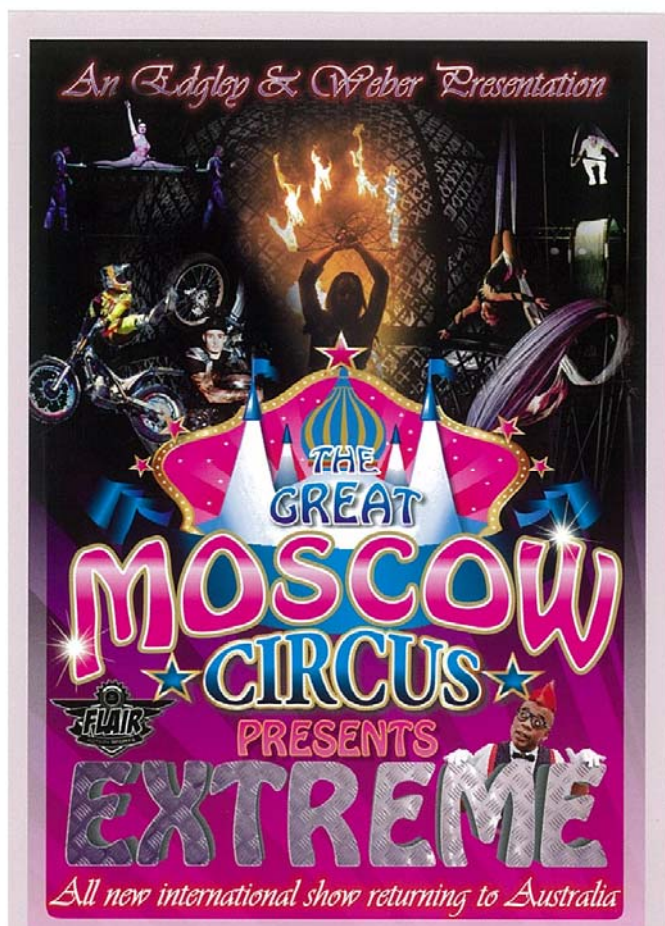
